Code of Conduct Agreement
Parent/Guardian/Supporter: 2025-26

As a parent/guardian/supporter of a JRBC registered athlete you have the responsibility to:

1. Ensure to the best of your ability that your child abides by the rules and principles of Jump Rope BC (JRBC) and Rope Skipping Canada (RSC).
2. Ensure to the best of your ability that your child shows good sportsmanship: respects his/ her teammates, coaches, tournament officials, judges, opponents, opposing coaches, and other participants at competitions, practices and other association activities.
3. Ensure to the best of your ability that your child conducts themselves in a manner that minimizes the risk of injury, both physically and psychologically, to themselves and others which includes refraining absolutely from making derogatory comments as to another individual's race, ethnic origin, colour, religion, gender and/or sexual orientation.
4. Ensure you and all supporters of your child refrain from criticism of teammates, coaches, tournament officials, judges, opponents, opposing coaches, and other participants at competitions, practices and other association activities and, when you feel that criticism is warranted, you shall offer it in a manner that is fully respectful, through proper channels.
5. Not post on any social media site with the goal to initiate, hurt, intimidate or humiliate any athlete, coach, official or spectator. These acts shall be considered harassment. If you see anything of concern from or about a JRBC official, coach, athlete or member you will immediately contact the JRBC President.
6. Ensure you and all supporters of your child refrain from directing comments which are insulting, intimidating, humiliating, hurtful, malicious, degrading or otherwise offensive to athletes, tournament officials, judges, coaches and association volunteers.
7. Ensure you don't use the official JRBC logo without formal written permission of the JRBC Board of Directors.
8. Familiarize yourself with and abide by the policies and procedures of JRBC and RSC.

As a Parent/Guardian/Supporter, if I'm found to be in violation of this policy, I may be subject to disciplinary action. Appeals or considerations are at the discretion of the JRBC Board.
